



For colts and fillies born in 2023, geldings excluded, registered in the Studbook of a U.E.T. member country.

U.E.T. has nominated the organisation of the race to racetrack with the following terms:

- The Eliminatories will be held on September 2027 at Paris-Vincennes racetrack and on September 2027 at Gothenburg-Åby racetrack. The date of the race will be decided by each organization. The start declaration will be registered by and ST.

The choice of the racetrack where the horses have to qualify is up to the decision of each trainer and owner.

A trainer is allowed to enter a horse in an Eliminatory race only in one country.

PURSE IN EURO:

Eliminatories : each one at least 30.000 €

Final: at least 350.000 €

The following countries enter all foals born in 2023 and registered in their Stud-Book on the basis of 10 Euros per foal: Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, The Netherlands, Norway, Spain, Sweden and Switzerland.

The list of the horses confirmed and the payment corresponding have to be sent to the UET secretariat before September 30^{th} of the year following the birth.

A confirmation of the entries and the payment of the requested fees, by the owners of the horses, has to be done at the following dates:

In addition a horse initially entered and for which the confirmation fees have not been paid may be supplemented in the race, by paying a fee of 20.000 € at the latest on August 1st 2027.

The owners confirming the entries of their horses will send the amounts corresponding to their Racing Authority where they are registered. The Racing Authorities will transmit, in the 15 days following the closing date, the list of horses confirmed or declared as a starter.

Besides the Racing Authority will send to the UET secretariat the payment:

- of the confirmations before December 31st of the year.
- of the start declaration within the 30 days after the closing date.

Maximum 12 runners in each Eliminatory race and in the UET Grand Prix Final are accepted. If only 12 start declarations are received for the Eliminatories, there will be only one race.

The number of Eliminatories races shall be decided according to the number of definitive Start Declarations received.

ELIMINATORIES:

The number of starting horses will determined the formula of Eliminatory, under the following conditions:

12 runners One Eliminatory race

13 to 24 runners Two Eliminatory races 37 to 48 runners Four Eliminatory races 25 to 36 runners Three Eliminatory races 49 to 60 runners Five Eliminatory races,

etc.

The number of places in the UET Grand Prix Final shall be distributed in proportion to the number of horses started in the Eliminatory races on both racetracks.

Should the number of horses to be qualified in the UET Grand Prix Final in the different Eliminatory races not be the same in each race, both racetracks shall first qualify the same number of horses per Eliminatory race. The remaining post positions in the Final are assigned on each racetrack to the horse coming next in the classification, having the best absolute time. If still a tie (the same 10th of a second), it will be a draw.

The post positions of the qualified horses in the UET Grand Prix Final, the name of the driver, the shoes declaration and all the elements requested by the country organising the race is fixed on the October,

If a horse qualified to the UET Grand Prix Final is not confirmed as a starter, it can, before the drawings of post positions in that race, be replaced by the next horse in the ranking of the relevant Eliminatory race.

The distribution of the horses in the different Eliminatory races containing the same number of horses at one unit, is done according to the present rules and can be consulted at the UET secretariat.

Should a horse be disqualified in an Eliminatory race as a result of a positive doping test, it will be automatically disqualified in the UET Grand Prix Final.

If a horse, after all the Eliminatory races, has been treated in a way that requires a 14 days or longer withdrawal period according to the "List of prohibited substances and withdrawal times" of the Swedish Trotting Association, the horse is not allowed to race in the UET Grand Prix Final.

No horse is allowed to take part in a race between the day after the date of declaration as a starter in an Eliminatory race and the race itself.


No horse is allowed to take part in a race between the Eliminatory races and the UET Grand Prix Final.


POST POSITION:

Eight (8) horses will start in the first row in each race. In the Eliminatory races, the post positions will be drawn by lots.

Horse number one of each country (with the highest life earnings) starts in the first line.

In the UET Grand Prix Final, the post positions shall first be drawn among the winners of the Eliminatory races, then among the seconds, the thirds, etc. The trainers and owners are authorized to choose their post position in this order.





RESPONSABILIES OF THE FEDERATIONS

Each Racing Authority is responsible for the holding of the list of the entries for the horses born and registered in its Stud-book and takes the commitment to contact the owners of horses for the various confirmations in due time.

PAYMENT OF THE FINAL

UET will pay to the organizer of the UET Grand Prix Final the amount effectively collected 30 days after the Final. It is up to the organizer, to complete the prize money announced.
